- * Suitable under tiles including in wet areas, provided an appropriate waterproofing system is used, which conforms to local building code requirements. DIN 18195 Part 1 defines the term "wet area" as "an interior area where on utilization water accumulates at such a rate as to require specific drainage to allow the water to dissipate." Bathrooms in a residential setting without specific floor drainage would not be considered a "wet area".
- ** Under elastic flooring a separating layer is recommended to avoid plasticizer migration.
